OUTCOMES

Communication:

Be able to share personal tastes, preferences, interests, and feelings. Ask for and give information using simple sentences.

Culture:

Demonstrate an appreciation and understanding of francophone cultures and compare them to their own culture.

Language:

Recognize vocabulary, structures and expressions related to the theme of study and daily classroom routines.

EXPECTATIONS

Daily participation in class enhances student language confidence and will ultimately lead to an increased level of success.

What will students learn?

Students will have 5 hours of French class during our 2 week schedule. Students of all language levels and from diverse language experience are able to participate to learn the French language through music, conversation, games, and other authentic exchanges.

The curriculum outcomes for Core French are based on the progressive development of communication in oral and written form using the Neurolinguistic Approach to language learning.

The Department of Education requires the Core French program to be 80% listening and speaking and 20% reading and writing. This end, much of the assessment will take place in the classroom and be based on conversation, observation, and production in relation to the expected learning outcomes.
