COURSE OVERVIEW

→ Social Studies 7 includes six major outcomes:

- ◆ Impact of Government Policies on Mi'kmaw
- Historical Opportunities and Challenges
- ◆ Impacts of Political Changes early 20th century
- ◆ Changing Societal Conditions
- ◆ Impact of World War 1 on the Maritimes
- ◆ Opportunities and Challenges of Today

Focus of the course: Canada 1820 - 1920

"Social Studies helps learners consider perspectives, think critically, and enables them to participate in society as well-informed, engaged citizens."

"An inquiry-based approach takes learners beyond the facts and figures of the period to a deeper understanding of the Civic, Economic, Geographic, and Historic conditions and impacts of the time. Learners should understand that the decisions, actions, and conditions of the period did not benefit all people."

EXPECTATIONS

- → Each student is expected to arrive on time to class each day with all materials necessary for learning, included charged Chromebooks.

ASSESSMENT

All teachers at SAJH are using the Department of Education's 1 to 4 scoring system for assessing outcomes:

- → 4 In-depth knowledge and understanding of content and concepts. **Exceeding** the outcome.
- → 3 Competent understanding demonstrated. **Meeting** the outcome.
- → 2 Developing an understanding. **Progressing** toward the outcome.
- → 1 Limited understanding demonstrated. **Not yet meeting** the outcome.

REPORT CARD DESCRIPTORS

90-100%- Demonstrates *excellent* understanding and application of concepts and skills in relation to the learning outcomes.

80-89% - Demonstrates *very good* understanding and application of concepts and skills in relation to the learning outcomes.

70-79% - Demonstrates *good* understanding and application of concepts and skills in relation to the learning outcomes.

60-69% - Demonstrates *satisfactory* understanding and application of concepts and skills in relation to the learning outcomes.

50-59%- Demonstrates *limited* understanding and application of concepts and skills in relation to the learning outcomes.

Below 50%- Has not met minimum requirements of the course

EXTRA HELP
