Curriculum Renewal

Entering its second year, Nova Scotia's curriculum is being renewed and modernized to ensure our students have the skills and competencies to be successful in a rapidly changing world. We are preparing our students for the future with curriculum that is inclusive, student-centred and flexible while maintaining a focus on literacy and numeracy.



Why Curriculum is Being Renewed

- To align with the <u>NS Teaching Standards</u>, the <u>Inclusive Education Policy</u> and the <u>Regional Student Success Plan</u>
- To develop students' skills while they explore their passions and interests
- To honor and respect each student's cultural and linguistic identities and knowledge systems
- To focus on student centered approaches that values, draws upon, and includes student voices and choices in their learning
- To support a universally-designed approach to teaching and learning

Integrated Learning Time

In our schedule next year, there is a substantial amount of time dedicated to what is called Integrated Learning Time (ILT.)

Every Tuesday Period 2, students will take part in lessons/sessions designed to build skills students will require to be successful in the 21st century.

Integrated Learning Time

Through the combining of student areas of interest with both inquiry and problem-based approaches to learning in our classrooms, we hope to guide our students toward developing the skills of Critical Thinking, Communication, Collaboration, and Creativity.




Integrated Learning Time

We hope to use student interests to:

- 1. Aid in the building of the many foundational skills that are required to effectively identify issues of importance, properly complete research on topics, analyze and evaluate research and
- 2. Communicate/collaborate with peers to solve real world problems (on both small and large scales.)

The focus of ILT for next year will center around three themes: Conflict (grade 7), Community (grade 8) and Change (grade 9)

Lunch Hour (supervised lunch room available)


Students arrive at first class of the afternoon

Class Schedule

- 10 day cycle (Week 1 and Week 2)
- 3 classes every morning 60 minutes in length
- Lunch 1 hour 20 minutes in length
- 2 classes every afternoon 60 minutes in length
- Students have English Language Arts & Mathematics everyday



Lunch Information

- While most of our students leave the building for lunch, St. Agnes offers a lunch room for students who are not in walking distance of the school and/or do not have access to home during school hours
- Lunch supervision is managed by a lunch monitor each day from 11:20-12:50
- Student are responsible for bringing their own lunch




Student Support

- Extra help offered (typically lunch hour)


Resource & Learning Centre
